Normal office running costs for December are still unmet by Friends of helper, however. Their customary monthly transfer has still not arrived despite chasing the UK sending bank and the recipient, NBC Kigoma. This seems to be an issue within the banking system and not Friends of helper. Elesia and Edy have made a number of visits to our bank to try to get to the bottom of it. Elisia has just come back today and thinks NBC may be safe to use, again, for transfers from Friends of helper and other other supporters. However, bank charges at this end on one recent donation were 15% on top of the ER - so please pay the bank charges at your end if possible!

One very generous supporter has just donated enough to cover the staff salaries!!!! Elisia brought the money just now and we are calling the staff in to receive the rest of the their salaries. Praise God they have largely been very understanding and patient.

So, to recap - the triplets are provided for and salaries are being given at the moment as staff arrive. Isn't that fantastic!

Now it is only running costs, we need until either the missing December Foh transfer finds its way here, or if irrevocably lost, then until the next one arrives. January is a big month for us with school children returning to their schools and this involves travelling to other cities, in some cases, so we are not out of the woods, yet, but thanks to you we feel we on the path!

Donations through Friends of helper qualify for tax reclaim, so once we are over this difficult patch and transfers are arriving normally, again, donations should go to Foh once more.
