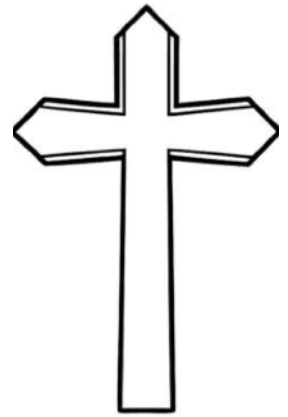


Happy Easter

Ishimwe says:

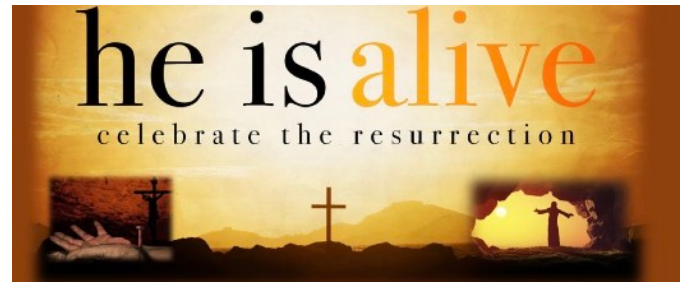
